Absentee ballot applications will be accepted by the Monroe County Board of Elections postmarked no later than **March 9th, 2010**. “A voter is eligible for an absentee ballot in the Village election if they are required to be absent from the County on that day because of duties, occupation, business or vacation or if they will be confined by illness either temporary or permanent.”
