Regarding the Proposed

Scottsville Regional Sanitary Sewer Pump Station and Force Main Project

There will be an informal public information meeting regarding the proposed “Scottsville Regional Sanitary Sewer Pump Station and Force Main” project, at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, June 21, 2010, in the Auditorium of the Wheatland-Chili Central School, 940 North Road.

It is proposed that the project would replace the forty year old Scottsville Wastewater Treatment Facility - which is located near River Road on Oatka Creek - with a new sanitary sewer pump station, and a 3.2 mile long forcemain extending northeasterly to the Monroe County Pure Waters Trunk Sewer located near the Thruway in the Town of Henrietta. Upon completion of the project, the old treatment plant would be decommissioned, and the new facilities would be operated and maintained by Pure Waters.

The presentation will describe the need for the proposed project and the scope of work proposed; outline the estimated cost of the project, the proposed financing plan and the potential impact of the project on sanitary sewer rates for homeowners within the Village of Scottsville and within the Northeast Sanitary Sewer District in the Town of Wheatland.

The meeting is sponsored by the Village of Scottsville, and the presentation will be given by the Village Engineers, MRB Group, PC. The meeting will be attended by local officials and by representatives from the Monroe County Department of Environmental Services, Division of Pure Waters.

Questions, comments and concerns from the public regarding the proposed project will be taken at the close of the presentation. Anyone interested is encouraged to attend.
