

PERMIT AND FEES

Any additional assessment fees for extra trash, refuse or special items must be processed at the Village Office during regular business hours. A label will be given to you for placement on the item, to show that you have paid the fee. Payment is by cash, credit, debit (plus bank processing fee) or check made to the Village of Scottsville.

- There is a limit of **one toter of garbage/refuse per week per resident** without extra charge. A second toter may be leased for an annual charge of \$75. There is an additional \$1 charge for containers and bags in excess.
- There is an extra charge per item for **furniture, mattresses and like items**.
- There is a \$35 charge per item for all **coolant appliances (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)** There is a \$25 charge for **older style televisions. Please consider Eco Park.**
- There is no charge for **metal products** if placed in neat piles or containers.
- **Wood products**, such as 2 by x's, must be free of nails and placed in bundles not to exceed 4 feet in length and not heavier than 50 pounds and no more than 4 bundles per household per week.

LEAF, BRUSH AND DEBRIS

- **Brush, Tree Trimmings, Shrubbery**, and other yard waste will be picked up April through September during the regular refuse collection cycles, except for **extreme** weather-related emergencies. If yard waste is generated outside of a scheduled general collection period, please call the DPW to make arrangements for pick-up. **Charges may apply.**
- The above must be cut into 4-foot lengths, **tied and bundled**. It must not be more than 4 inches in diameter and must not be heavier than 50 pounds. Limit 5 bundles per week. If these conditions are not met, it will not be picked up.

- Village residents may drop off their brush at the DPW Brush Recycling Center during the work week. Please call ahead. Proof of residency is required for dumping.
- For hauling large amount of brush, a village resident may have a DPW truck dropped off at a charge of \$25 per day, per load. Please call ahead for this option. Removal of trees, plants, and shrubbery on private property is the sole responsibility of the homeowner.
- Removal of home improvement and construction debris, including and not limited to roofing materials, drywall, plywood, sinks, etc. is the sole responsibility of the homeowner.
- There will be weekly leaf vacuuming during October through early December. Dates will be posted. **No brush pick-up during leaf season.**
- Leaves must be raked as close as possible to the road and in long rows (if possible) instead of a big mound.
- Grass clippings and all lawn rakings **must be placed in recyclable paper bags. No plastic bags.** Paper bags for lawn debris are available for purchase at most home improvement stores.
- **Do not bag leaves or use containers** during this time.
- **Do not mix brush, nuts, apples or other trash** with the leaves during this time.

UNACCEPTABLE WASTE:

Volatile Materials, Infectious Waste, Human Waste, Junk Vehicles, Noxious Materials, Gas Tanks, Tires, Paint Cans with Paint (empty dry cans OK), Propane Tanks, Motor Oil, Animal Waste, Auto Parts (including batteries).

No liquids, hazardous or toxic waste materials.

WEEKLY GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION

GARBAGE/REFUSE MUST BE AT CURBSIDE BY 7 AM

- Refuse is collected Mondays and Tuesdays, unless there is a holiday. When collection falls on a holiday, pick-up will occur the next day.
- Recycling is collected every Wednesday, except for holidays. Refer to the calendar on back for pick up dates. When a holiday falls prior or on collection day, then pick-up will be the next day. Single-stream recycling is in place. You do not need to separate your items. Residents can bring recycling to the DPW Garage, 389 Scottsville-Mumford Road, during regular DPW working hours.
