Monthly Report:

- · Call/Activity summary May
- Looking to purchase a New Chief Truck this year not to exceed \$45,000. Current Chief's truck is a 2010 with 145,000 miles, which would be passed down to 4c36. According to Jen, there will be over \$52,000 in the truck reserve. We talked about this in the budget meeting in the spring and everyone was in agreement if we had the money. I will get prices for state bid to find the best prices for Scottsville and have more info next month.
- 4626 at the meeting for all to look at.
- Air-packs due to be replaced around the same time as the radios. Right now under the 2013 standard, packs are around \$6,000 plus \$400 for spare bottle and \$260 for a mask. Good news is that the 2018 standard is coming out January 1<sup>st</sup>, the new NFPA standard will drive the cost up 10% per item listed above. We need to have a discussion on Air-packs and radios.
- 4617 final inspection was June 12<sup>th</sup> in Buffalo, couple of things still needing to be fixed and equipment mounted.

- 4617 will be going to the NYS Chiefs Show at Turning Stone June 15<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup> then back to Buffalo for equipment mounting.
- Will be getting 4 sets of turnout gear due to 1 failure and 3 out of date sets with helmets we have no helmets in stock.
- Also looking to split money with the fire company 50/50 on new camera for 17. Replacing a first generation thermal technology camera bought in the 90's. Replacement batteries are not available anymore.
- Level 0 Haz-mat on Scottsville West Henrietta 4613 lost a fuel tank while coming home from training and 60 gal was spilled on the ground. Thank you to the Village DPW for helping to clean up.
- · Fire Department needs to be paved. This needs to move forward.
